



Statement:

The Oklahoma City Public School District administration just became aware of the allegations from a former US Grant High School teacher; district leaders will conduct an investigation into the allegations. –Karl Springer, OKCPS Superintendent

Questions:

1. Yes, the allegations regarding grade changing are restricted to Douglass Mid-High School.
2. As statement provided reads, the district just became aware of the allegations and will conduct an investigation.
3. As the statement provided reads, the district just became aware of the allegations.
4. US Grant HS received Federal School Improvement Grant (SIG) funds beginning in 2010-2011 school year, via a 3 year grant awarded to the state for the lowest performing schools. The school has also received school improvement funds (same name, different set of funds) for 5 years in the amount of \$1 million.
5. The funds awarded to US Grant HS have been used in accordance with the federal guidelines approved through the Federal School Improvement Grant.
6. US Grant HS staff members received signing bonuses in 2010; additional compensation has NOT been provided because SMART goals were not met and the district has not received scores from the most recent school year.
7. Tami Sanders, principal at US Grant High School annual salary \$85,395,00
8. Dr. Linda Ware Toure, Executive Director for School Turnaround annual salary \$113,787.00
9. US Grant High School: no, the district just became aware of the allegations.
Douglass Mid-High School: no, the investigation is still underway.
10. In regards to Douglass Mid-High, the allegations involve grade changing which is a separate issue.
11. The district has retained an outside attorney to conduct the investigation.
12. Hourly rate \$150.
