It has recently come to my attention that the employees at California Virtual Academies (CAVA) made the decision to unionize with the California Teachers Association. I simply want to convey my support for their decision and am confident they are committed to improving both learning and teaching conditions at CAVA.

A primary purpose of California's public education system is to educate and prepare students to participate in our democratic institutions, culture and society. It is crucial that we maintain the public character of our public education system.

Since your Charter and Charter Renewal Agreement expressly acknowledge your schools to be the exclusive public school employer of the employees within the meaning of the Educational Employment Act, I anticipate that CAVA will fully honor the employees' rights to organize under PERB.

Further, in the months to come when PERB certifies the union as the exclusive representative, you will have the opportunity to collectively bargain with the educators who work at CAVA.
