Agreement with <u>Reverent Al Sharpton</u> ("Guest Speaker") for his presentation on <u>January</u> 14, 2015 at The Ohio State University (Office of Diversity and Inclusion).

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth herein and intending to be legally bound hereby, the parties agree as follows:

1. Scope of Services

- The Guest Speaker will give a presentation in conjunction with Dr. Jamal Watson as
 part of <u>The Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration</u> by the Frank W. Hale, Jr.
 Black Cultural Center or Office of Diversity and Inclusion of The Ohio State University
 at The Ohio State University on the following date(s): <u>January 14</u> (2015).
- The conversation/dialogue must be related to the theme and celebration of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
- For this Engagement, he will receive an honorarium of \$12,500.00 (with \$6,250.00 sent in advance as a holding fee for the program).
- The program will take place in this campus location: The Ohio Ballroom, 1739 North High Street, Columbus, Ohio 43210-1302
- A photograph and biographical material will need to be sent to a designated OSU personnel

2. <u>Compensation</u>

The Ohio State University will provide the Guest Speaker with lodging for 2 rooms at
the Blackwell Inn and Conference Center, 2110 Tuttle Park Place, Columbus, Ohio
43210 (on the campus of The Ohio State University) January 15, 2015 for lodging and
for meals. Original itemized receipts must be submitted (alcohol cannot be included in
the food receipts).

3. Indemnification

The Ohio State University agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Guest Speaker and his/her agents from and against any claims, costs, expenses, damages, liabilities, losses or judgments ("Losses") arising out of, or in connection with, any claim, demand or action by a third party, if such Losses are sustained as a direct or indirect consequence of the Engagement, excepting any Losses that are caused solely by the negligence of Guest Speaker and his/her agents. Guest Speaker shall indemnify and hold harmless University, its trustees, officers, employees and agents from and against any Losses arising solely out of the negligent acts of Guest Speaker and his/her agents associated with the Engagement.

4. <u>Independent Contractor</u>

Guest Speaker is an independent contractor and is not an employee, agent, servant, joint venture, partner or affiliate of or with The Ohio State University. University shall have no right to exercise control or direction over the activities of the Guest Speaker except as provided herein. Guest Speaker acknowledges that no federal, state or local taxes will be withheld from the compensation paid to Guest Speaker under this Agreement, nor will Guest Speaker receive any employee benefits from the University, including but not limited to pension, health, social security, workers' compensation, or other insurance.

5. Severability

The covenants in this Agreement are severable and if any covenant or portion thereof is held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such covenant or portion thereof shall be modified or adjusted to the extent necessary to cure the invalidity or unenforceability, and all other covenants or provisions shall remain valid and enforceable.

6. Entire Agreement

This Agreement and the exhibits attached hereto express the entire agreement between the parties regarding the Engagement to be performed hereunder, and supersedes all prior agreements, understanding, and negotiations involving the parties regarding the Engagement, whether written or oral, consistent or inconsistent, or otherwise. This Agreement may not be amended, modified, waived, terminated or clarified except by

written agreement signed by both parties. All changes made herein are binding on both parties

7. Choice of Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Ohio. state

8. Termination

If the Guest Speaker is unable to carry out the Engagement for reasons beyond his or her control, or if College is unable to host the Engagement for reasons beyond its control, this agreement is cancelled and its terms are null and void.
